Everyone with a demonstrable connection to Bowen Island who is pursuing academic study at a recognized Canadian post-secondary institution is encouraged to apply. Preference will be shown to those graduating from high school. Though the award is selected on the basis of academic achievement, two equally strong candidates will be differentiated on the basis of community involvement.

Please use the following **Checklist** when preparing your application:

Each applicant must submit:

- Their full name, mailing address, telephone number, and e-mail.
- A **letter** demonstrating their:
 - Personal connection to Bowen Island and the Bowen community
 - Career goals and academic performance
 - Need for the scholarship and how the scholarship would make a difference
- **Proof of acceptance** at a recognized Canadian post-secondary institution, including the applicant's student number and the address of the institution
- A **letter of reference** from someone other than a relative and contact information for that reference. A reference may be contacted to confirm the accuracy of the letter.
- A **transcript** from the applicant's present or most recent educational institution. Official transcripts may be required if the applicant is successful
